



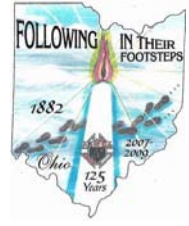

Family Fun Day!



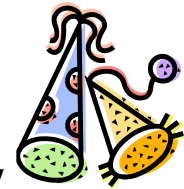
