

**OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP ATHLETIC ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES  
FEBRUARY 22, 2010**

**BOARD MEETING**

The meeting was called to order with a prayer at 6:30 p.m.

**Members Present:** Michelle Fulks, Amanda Padamadan, Bill Stover, Joe Dimel, Jerry Testa, Scott Lindsey, Susan Donovan, and Debbie Badger

**Approval of Minutes:** A motion to approve the Minutes for the January, 2010 meeting was made by Michelle Fulks and seconded by Joe Dimel.

**Reports:**

**Girls' AD's:**

Scott reported the following basketball standings for John Ruth:

Mike Ciotola's 8<sup>th</sup> grade team finished the season 7-3 and lost their tournament game.

John Ruth's 7<sup>th</sup> grade team is 12-0 to date. They won their league, and are playing for the tournament championship on Sunday, February 28<sup>th</sup>, at 3:20 pm at DeSales.

John Ruth's 6<sup>th</sup> grade team is 12-0 to date. They won their league, and are playing for the tournament championship on Sunday, February 28<sup>th</sup>, at 5:40 pm at St. Agatha.

Jim McAndrew's 6<sup>th</sup> grade team finished 7-4 and lost their tournament game.

Jamie Williamson's 5<sup>th</sup> grade team is 2-7 and has one game remaining.

Patrick Dick's 5<sup>th</sup> grade team is 4-6 and has one game remaining.

Jason Strausbaugh's 4<sup>th</sup> grade team is 6-3 and has one game remaining.

**Boys' AD's:**

Scott reported the following basketball standing for Rich Williamson:

The 8<sup>th</sup> grade competitive team is still playing.

The two 8<sup>th</sup> grade rec teams play on Tuesday to get into the championship game. If both teams win or lose, they will not play each other. Only if one of the two teams win, will they play for a championship.

Both 6<sup>th</sup> grade teams lost their first tournament game.

The 5<sup>th</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade teams have one game remaining.

**K-3 Director:**

Joe reported that a total of 130 children have signed up for K-3 basketball, including:

37 – Pre-K and K

29 – 1<sup>st</sup> graders

38 – 2<sup>nd</sup> graders

21 – 3<sup>rd</sup> graders

Joe also discussed the use of colored wristbands to enable the coach's to match similar talent when determining match-ups. This was approved by the Board.

Joe then discussed offering a "snack ticket" for \$1.00. This would be optional to the parent's and could replace the need to bring snacks/drinks to the game. Joe will investigate the cost of a small drink/granola bar and will proceed if cost-effective.

**Pastoral Coordinator:**

Other than a reminder that the building needs to be lock up after use, Mrs. Donovan had nothing to report.

**Athletic Director:**

Scott discussed the need to inform new incoming board members of the level of dedication and participation that would be expected. There are several positions that will be available for the upcoming year.

**Financial Update:**

We are currently showing a deficit of roughly \$3700. This is down from last month's report due to basketball admissions and concessions.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

### **Spring Sports:**

The deadline was extended for spring sports sign-ups due to the snow days.

21 have signed up for track:

6 – 4<sup>th</sup> graders

3 – 5<sup>th</sup> graders

4 – 6<sup>th</sup> graders

4 – 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> graders

A budget of \$500 was approved for track.

47 have signed up for softball:

13 – 4<sup>th</sup> graders

8 – 5<sup>th</sup> graders

10 – 6<sup>th</sup> graders

9 – 7<sup>th</sup> graders

7 – 8<sup>th</sup> graders

There are currently coaches for all 5 teams. A budget of \$400 was approved for softball.

36 have signed up for baseball:

12 – 4<sup>th</sup> graders

4 – 5<sup>th</sup> graders

6 – 6<sup>th</sup> graders

3 – 7<sup>th</sup> graders

11 – 8<sup>th</sup> graders

We will probably combine the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders and the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. We are in need of one additional coach.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

### **Fee Breakdown:**

Scott discussed the fee breakdown for sports. All sports, except K-3, lose money. These sports are subsidized by the Board through fundraisers. Also, even though there is a fee for uniforms, this fee does not cover the entire cost of the uniforms. The difference also is subsidized by the Board.
