Scott Lindsey reported that we currently have a \$3500 deficit for this school year. There are minimal expenses remaining outstanding and the payout of the tuition raffle. The winner of the tuition raffle will be drawn on Sunday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, after the noon mass by Mrs. Donovan. Scott also passed out a list of sports fees for the 2010-2011 school year.

**OLD BUSINESS:****Spring Sports:**

Scott Lindsey reported that Dan Kopek is stepping down as the commissioner and head coach for track. Rich Green is a possibility to take his place. Baseball and softball will be over after tonight. Scott discussed the baseball and softball coaches coordinate the cleaning of the athletic building/concession stand.

**Parent Meetings:**

The first meeting was held on May 17<sup>th</sup> and was attended by 60 parents. The second meeting has been scheduled for Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 pm, with a third meeting scheduled for Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, at 8 pm, following curriculum night.

**Retractable Basketball Hoop:**

Scott Lindsey had a preliminary discussion with Mike Halko regarding vinyl banners. Jerry Testa and Bob Bair will follow-up with additional companies for bids, and we will discuss this again at our June meeting.

**Golf Outing:**

Amanda Padamadan announced various sponsorships that have been sold. It was decided that we have ample can coolers and golf balls from previous years and only need to purchase golf towels. Michelle Fulks will offset a portion the cost of this with her sponsorship.

**Fall Sports Sign-ups:**

Sign-up forms for fall sports were passed out at the first parent meeting and also e-mailed to all parents. Cheerleading forms were due yesterday and to date there are only 6 participants. Late forms will be accepted with the payment of the late fee.

There was then a lengthy discussion regarding football. Bill Stover has met with St. Cecilia regarding merging with OLPH for football. Neither program has the numbers for a successful program. After much discussion regarding the name of the team, helmets, jerseys, practice venues and game venues and coaching, it was decided that we need to communicate this issue ASAP to the parents. Jerry Testa will be drafting a letter for the Board's approval to go out to all parents and a parent's meeting will be scheduled to discuss any concerns.

Scott Lindsey would like to schedule a mandatory coaches' meeting similar to the mandatory parent's meetings to address expectations for the coaches.
